From Monday to Saturday during a certain week, a market will feature six different types of fish, exactly one type of fish per day. The fish—halibut, John Dory, orange roughy, pomfret, rockfish, and sardines—are either farm-raised or wild-caught.

The following conditions apply:

The fish featured on Monday or Saturday, but not both, are wild-caught.

Either halibut, which is farmed, or John Dory, which is wild-caught, is featured on Tuesday.

Wild-caught fish are not featured on consecutive days.

Neither the rockfish nor the sardines are wild-caught.

Pomfret, which is wild-caught, is featured on Thursday.
