Either halibut, which is farmed, or John Dory, which is wild-caught, is featured on Tuesday.

Wild-caught fish are not featured on consecutive days. Neither the rockfish nor the sardines are wild-caught.

Pomfret, which is wild-caught, is featured on Thursday.
