Directions: Each group of questions in this section is based on a set of conditions. In answering some of the questions, it may be useful to draw a rough diagram. Choose the response that most accurately and completely answers each question and blacken the corresponding space on your answer sheet.

Questions 1–8

A circus must select at least four clowns from among a group of seven—Marny, Nifty, Oscar, Porky, Rascal, Sunny, and Vinny—to perform in a traveling show. The selection of clowns must conform to the following conditions:

Exactly two of Rascal, Sunny, and Vinny are selected.

If Nifty is not selected, then Oscar must be selected.

Oscar cannot be selected unless Rascal is selected.

Porky cannot be selected unless Sunny is selected.

If Marny is selected, then Nifty cannot be selected.

- If Sunny is not selected, then which one of the following must be true?
 - Oscar is selected.
 - Marny is selected.
 - Nifty is not selected.
 - Rascal is not selected.
 - Vinny is not selected.
- If exactly five clowns are selected, then which one of the following must be false?
 - Rascal is selected.
 - Vinny is not selected.
 - Marny is not selected.
 - Nifty is selected.
 - Porky is not selected.
- If Oscar is not selected, then which one of the following must be true?
 - Rascal is selected.
 - Neither Marny nor Vinny is selected.
 - Sunny is selected.
 - Porky is not selected.
 - Nifty is not selected.
- If neither Nifty nor Porky is selected, then which one of the following could be true?
 - Exactly five clowns are selected.
 - Oscar is not selected.
 - Vinny is not selected.
 - Marny is not selected.
 - Both Vinny and Sunny are selected.
- If Rascal is not selected, then which one of the following must be true?
 - Sunny is not selected.
 - Porky is selected.
 - Vinny is not selected.
 - Marny is selected.
 - Nifty is not selected.
- Which of the following could be a complete and accurate list of the clowns selected?
 - Nifty, Porky, Rascal, Sunny
 - Marny, Oscar, Porky, Sunny, Vinny
 - Marny, Nifty, Porky, Rascal, Sunny
 - Marny, Porky, Sunny, Vinny
 - Nifty, Porky, Rascal, Vinny
- Which of the following could be a complete and accurate list of the clowns NOT selected?
 - Marny, Rascal
 - Oscar, Rascal
 - Marny, Nifty
 - Nifty, Vinny
 - Marny, Oscar, Porky, Rascal
- Each of the following could be true EXCEPT:
 - Neither Marny nor Nifty is selected.
 - Neither Oscar nor Vinny is selected.
 - Neither Marny nor Porky is selected.
 - Neither Nifty nor Rascal is selected.
 - Neither Sunny nor Porky is selected.
