Questions 1-5

The Trippy Trips Travel Agency is offering a promotion through which a traveler can pay a fixed fee to visit exactly six cities. The traveler can choose from three Italian cities—Florence, Genoa, and Latina—three Spanish cities—Madrid, Oviedo, and Pamplona—and four United States Cities—Reno, San Francisco, Tampa, and Washington DC. When selecting six cities to visit, the traveler must choose according to the following restrictions:

More Spanish cities than Italian cities must be selected. Reno and Washington DC cannot both be selected. Genoa and Madrid cannot both be selected. If San Francisco is selected, then both Pamplona and Genoa must be selected.
