The Theater Festival Game

Questions 1-8

The town of Smithville is holding a theater festival. During the festival, 6 plays will be performed: one evening show on each of Thursday and Friday, and both an afternoon matinée and an evening show on each of Saturday and Sunday. The six plays are directed by Gore, Harrison, Irving, Janus, Klein and Langston, not necessarily in that order. Two of the plays were written by Miller, two by Nicholls, and two by O'Neill. The order in which the plays are performed is consistent with the following conditions:

Both of the plays written by Miller must be performed on the same day.

The play directed by Irving must be performed during a matinée.

The play directed by Klein was written by O'Neill, and must be performed before the play directed by Langston, but after the play directed by Janus.

Both plays written by Nicholls must be performed before either play written by Miller.

Gore does not direct either play written by Miller. Harrison does not direct either play written by Nicholls.

 - (C) The play directed by Gore is performed sometime on Sunday.
 - (D) The play directed by Irving was written by O'Neill and performed at the Sunday matinée.
 - (E) The play directed by Klein is performed on Sunday evening.
